# A MULTI-STAKEHOLDER APPROACH TO INTEGRITY IN THE PRIVATE SECTOR

## OVERVIEW

Corruption is one of the most insidious and corrosive threats to the economic and political order of societies. In addition to facilitating other forms of serious crime phenomena and weakening the capacity of institutions to respond to them, corruption also undermines trust and fair competition in the private sector. The importance of preventing and combatting corruption among businesses is recognized, *inter alia*, by Article 12 of the United Nations Convention against Corruption (UNCAC).

The UNCAC provides a framework for an integrated, multi-stakeholder approach to preventing and combatting corruption, including in the private sector. In line with such an approach, this event – co-organized by IACA and the Permanent Mission of Italy to the International Organizations in Vienna – will bring together experts of the Italian Government, Anti-Corruption Authorities, civil society, and academia, as well as representatives of the private sector.

The event will showcase examples and best practices of business integrity and anti-corruption. The speakers will discuss the international experience of public-private collaboration and implementation of anti-corruption compliance, and their aspirations and commitments to shaping a more transparent and fair economic environment, both domestically and internationally.
