ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum of five years of relevant work experience, or alternatively a level of junior engagement demonstrating the applicant's potential
- Citizen or resident of one of the following: Bahrain, Egypt, Iraq, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Sudan, Syrian Arab Republic, Tunisia, United Arab Emirates, Yemen; and the State of Palestine
- Proficiency in written and spoken English

Participants will be selected taking into account their professional and academic experience.
